



Boron Chamber of Commerce Meeting Minutes

July 11, 2005

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by President F.O. Roe. The minutes were approved as read.

Reports

20 Mule Team Museum: \$400 in memorials have come in lately. Thank you to the clean-up crew. A young man will be doing court-ordered community service to clean up, also.

Aerospace: The need for new docents is becoming critical. Ken Mason has some items to donate on a long-term loan. Hugh is working on getting them moved.

A check was received from RocketBoosters for \$2,500. The total received from Rocketboosters is now \$8,600. A check for \$13 was also received from Hartford as a refund on insurance.

Barbara reported that we have 200 coupons to sell for unlimited rides at the AV Fair.

She also reported that the AV Press would like the Chamber to run an ad before the fair. The motion was made and carried to run the ad.

F.O. reported that Carrol Core Park is now in escrow and the first payment will be due August 5th or 6th.

New Business

Hugh made the motion to use the \$8,600 from Rocketboosters as a down payment on the park. The motion was seconded and it carried. Hugh also purposed planting hedges along the fence at the Aerospace Museum as money becomes available.

Monroe suggested we purchase a banner to raise money for the park. The motion was made, seconded, and carried to buy a banner for around \$60.

F. O. brought up the problem of the lack of medical services in our area. Barbara will bring a written report to the next meeting.
